



The Stables Supplier Venue Information

Welcome to Bendooley Estate, we are delighted to be working with you to create a truly memorable event for our couples.

The access driveway into “The Stables” is restricted to left-in only, therefore all suppliers must arrive from the south along the Old Hume Highway. Suppliers arriving from the north along the Hume Motorway should take the Berrima exit (Medway Road exit), then head north along the Old Hume Highway to “The Stables”.

CEREMONY SET-UP

- The ceremony location for evening weddings is situated in the courtyard at the entrance to The Stables, either in front of the entry to The Stables or by the water feature.
- The ceremony location for lunch weddings is situated in the paddocks overlooking the lake and Homestead gardens - all styling must be removed from this area by 2:00pm on the day of the wedding.
- For lunch weddings in the paddocks, power is not available therefore please bring battery powered amps.
- Bendooley staff will arrange for ceremony benches to be in position three hours prior to the ceremony commences.
- As per our Terms and Conditions with our couple, flowers petals or confetti are not permitted at the ceremony location.
- The noise level of all PA systems, bands and DJ's will be at the discretion of Bendooley staff and will be monitored by a decibel meter.
- Photography areas after 2:00pm are shown in the drone image below, any photographers who venture outside of this area will be banned from Bendooley Estate.

THE STABLES (RECEPTION)

- Florists and Stylists will have access to The Stables for floral installations into the ceiling five hours prior to the ceremony commencing.
- When installing foliage or flowers into the ceiling, please ensure a drop sheet is placed on the floor.
- All suppliers including florists styling tables only will have access to The Stables three hours prior to the ceremony.
- A custom-built Floral Prep Room is available for florists and stylists throughout the day of the wedding; this is located at the loading dock.
- Florists styling with candles in their reception set up must light all candles prior to departing the premises. All candles must be in a glass sleeve or hurricane candle holder. Candles must be lit by the florist/stylist during the set-up. Candle sticks are not allowed at The Stables, unless in a glass sleeve.
- All deliveries and unloading of equipment (band, florist, stylist, cake etc.) must be made via the loading dock at the rear of The Stables. Vehicles must be moved from this area immediately after unpacking.
- Bands and DJ's must complete a sound check no later than one hour prior to the ceremony commencing.
- All Bands and DJ's must plug their equipment into The Stables in-house sound system, please refer to the PA system document for further information.

FURTHER INFORMATION
